

Drill a 6mm or larger hole right above the pivot point of the swing- arm. Take a pin punch with a flat tip and punch the locking wire into the groove of the gearbox about every 1/2" around it's diameter. To rotate the gearbox all the way around, the pin that is used to turn the gearbox to the different patterns, must be removed (the pin is just pressed in).
